



There's a group of 40+ Bible College Students heading off for a Mission Trip in December this year. We're hoping to serve in three places. Firstly, we're heading to Palu – that's the place that has just been devastated by earthquakes/tsunamis. We'll be helping with the rebuilding process there and seeing how we can serve. We're hoping to serve alongside a couple of churches there. Then we're hiking to a very remote place in the mountains to share with a largely unreached animistic people group. There is a small church plant there – a small community of believers who have recently turned to Christ. We want to encourage them and share with others in the area. This is a very remote area, so please pray for safety. We'll also be taking clothes, medicines, etc., as gifts to the community. Finally, we'll then be travelling to another area called Memuju (which is a town in West Sulawesi), and holding some Christmas services as an outreach to the people there. We've also been given an opportunity to share at a high-school there, so we'll be hoping to share the good news with the students. Please pray for us. There is much to be organised. Roads also need to be rebuilt so that we can reach our destinations. There is much that could go wrong, but much that could happen. We're hoping for great things. Thank you for your partnership!
